

USU Outreach in Tropical Medicine 2019

Overarching learning objective: To familiarize healthcare providers with identifying and applying patient context to tropical medicine and related case management.

Specific learning objectives: Objectives for each of the four types of sessions follow.

Induction.

- Identify common elements among designated focus areas for the week that can be applied together in clinical case management.
- Contrast aspects of the week's focus areas that highlight examples of specific knowledge important to the care of patients in a particular context or condition.

Maintenance.

- Practice common and specific elements of the week's focus areas through mentored clinical case review and discussion.

Consolidation.

- Through question and answer, discussion, and additional case review, reinforce lessons in clinical case management applicable to the week's focus areas.
- Translate these lessons to roles, opportunities, and challenges of tropical medicine practice as a member of the federal workforce.

Tropical Medicine Rounds.

- On designated days, conduct a journal article review and discussion on an example from the literature related to that or a previous week's focus areas.
- Present unique federal workforce context in tropical medicine practice and other topics such as public health and research and development relevant to understanding and applying unique aspects of work in the field.
- Through case review, question and answer, and discussion, reinforce lessons in clinical case management applicable to any topic covered to date in that or a previous week's focus areas.
