

Subject: Navy Intern Director Position Opening

Applications are being accepted for the position of Navy Intern Director at Walter Reed National Military Medical Center. We are looking for an inspirational and capable Navy Medical Corps Officer (senior O-4 and above) with an interest in Graduate Medical Education. This is an outstanding opportunity to assume a significant leadership position within the hospital which involves our 66 GME programs, 16 allied health programs, and nearly 700 trainees. Formal GME experience is desirable but not necessary. Candidates will be judged on demonstrated leadership, experience and expertise, interpersonal and mentoring skills, reputation of excellence, and commitment to the mission at Walter Reed National Military Medical Center. The time commitment for this position is estimated to be 0.2 FTE, and includes the following duties:

1. Member of the ACGME Clinical Learning Environment Review (CLER) Executive Committee which directs initiatives as related to patient safety, healthcare quality, transitions in care, supervision of trainees, professionalism, and duty hours/fatigue management.
2. Attendance at monthly Graduate Medical Education Committee (GMEC) meetings.
3. Member of the closed Academic Hearing Subcommittee which specifically deals with residents on academic probation or brought forward by their program leadership for proposed probation and/or termination.
4. Attendance at GME team meetings
5. Assists the Navy Assistant Chief of GME with the Navy GME FITREP Ranking Boards.
6. Assists with the coordination of multiple educational forums to include Navy Operational Medicine Day, Intern Orientation, Career Transition Workshop, and GME Graduation.
7. Performs all other duties or functions as required by the position or as tasked by the Chief of Graduate Medical Education.

Applications are open to any Active Duty Navy Medical Corps Officer assigned to Walter Reed in the grade of O-4 to O-6.
