Director for Branch Clinics Naval Hospital Camp Pendleton (NHCP)

The Director for Branch Clinics (DBC) implements his/her vision for the future in accordance with the command's mission, vision and guiding principles and executes the administrative workload and oversight of 18 Branch Medical Clinics, Marine Centered Medical Home and Sports Medicine Clinics across Marine Corps Base (MCB) Camp Pendleton, Navy Medicine Readiness and Training Unit (NMRTU) Port Hueneme and NMTRU Yuma. The DBC cultivates a collaborative work environment among the Department Heads, Officers-in-Charge and Senior Medical Officers. The DBC is responsible for obtaining, maintaining, and implementing available resources to provide timely, safe, quality and clinically-skilled patient care. The incumbent also provides guidance and direction to leaders within the directorate regarding administrative matters, management of personnel, budgetary issues and clinic management.

The DBC serves as the principle individual reporting to the NMRTC Commander / Naval Hospital Camp Pendleton (NHCP) Director and Executive Officer (XO) to ensure the NMRTC and NHCP assist the I Marine Expeditionary Force and multiple tenant commands of MCB Camp Pendleton in the delivery of high-quality patient care.

The position is open to Navy Medical Department Officers of all Corps at the O-5 / O-6 level with a professional clinical background.

The preferred candidate will have the following attributes:

- 1) A track record of superior performance in positions of leadership
- 2) A working knowledge of Clinical Management processes and Business Management
- 3) A solid understanding of Quality Management, Process Improvement and Customer Service
- 4) Strong management skills with experience in civilian personnel management
- 5) A keen understanding of the strategic imperatives of a Military Treatment Facility
- 6) Significant interpersonal, communicative, and collaborative skills
- 7) Superior military bearing
