NEW ANONYMOUS FACULTY LISTENING POST

The Office of Faculty Affairs launched an anonymous post intended to provide a safe and confidential venue to report incidents or concerns involving bias, abuse, hostility, unprofessional behavior, and non-inclusive experiences. This can also be used for any faculty concerns about processes, and suggestions are appreciated as well. Note: You can choose to remain anonymous; no information will be collected about you. You may also choose to identify yourself, and if so, agree to follow-up contact regarding your report. These will be discussed by a small group of faculty for action, further information gathering, and will be reported annually to the faculty.

Academic Promotion and the newly signed 1100A

The "1100A" is the name for the document outlining faculty appointments and promotion in the School of Medicine. Qualifications for promotion are explicitly defined in Section 4. There are also new one-pagers for promotion requirements in each faculty track and pathway.

Both the signed 1100A and the one-pagers are found in 2 locations:

- Faculty Affairs intranet site for those who have access. Look in the upper right corner for the "Appointment and Promotion" pull-down https://sites.google.com/usuhs.edu/facultyaffairs/home
- Faculty Development Self-Service Site under the "Resources" tab on the left

Military Medicine Ambassadors (MMAs) are "field" representatives of military medicine, located across the United States and the world, who provide information to interested pre-medical students and medical school applicants about medical school officer accession pathways, Uniformed Services University (USU), and the Health Professions Scholarship Program (HPSP). Anyone who has a sincere interest in military medicine, including students, may participate as an MMA in recruitment events.

One of the goals of this program is for MMAs to develop relationships with pre-medical programs, pre-health advisors, military recruiters, and interested applicants by sharing their personal experiences and knowledge about life as a uniformed physician and their medical school journey. Another goal is to increase the visibility and representation of USU as a modern, diverse medical school with superior medical training, extensive leadership development, and innovative field experiences. Volunteers are able to participate as their schedules permit, and they will be provided with all the information and supplies necessary for a successful event. Training, both asynchronous and/or live virtual, may be required annually to participate, and MMAs can utilize this training and recruitment work for their professional resume or curriculum vitae.
